100% Viognier

Blanco de blancas is the result of the blend of the white varietals of the Alto de Inazares project, where Viognier and Chardonnay dominate, with the rest of the varieties contributing a wide aromatic and taste complexity.

CONTEXT

Growing area: Inazares.

(Moratalla-Region of north-west Murcia)

Production area: Inazares. On the property.

Plot: Las Perreras, (viognier) El Altico (chardonnay), El Roal (gewurztraminer, Sauvignon blanc), El Corral (riesling).

Soil: Clay-calcareous, alluvium, with grey loams on the surface.

Thin arable topsoil, on limestone bedrock.

Climate: Dry continental climate with influence of mountain climate. Hurricane-force winds, precipitation in the form of snow.

Altitude: 1,373 m.

VINEYARD

Variety: Viognier, Chardonnay, Gewurztraminer, Riesling, Sauvignon Blanc, on trellis, Cordon Royat single.

Organic growing.

Year-planted: 2011.

HARVEST AND VINIFICATION

Harvest of September 14th - 15th, 2021.

0.3 - 0.8 kg/vine. 12 kg boxes.

Destemmed and lightly crushed.

Natural settling by sedimentation for 24 hours.

Malolactic fermentation.

Aging in stainless steel tank for 6 months.

Clarification with pea protein and bentonite.

Light filtration (between 3 and 5 microns).

Mixture of grapes: Viognier 60%; Chardonnay 39% Syrah; others 1%.

Alcohol content: 13.5% Vol.

Total acidity: 4.05 g/l. Volatile acidity: 0.28 g/l.

pH: 3.65. Total sulphur: 94 mg/l.
