

PINOT NOIR 2021



100% Pinot Noir

A grape exclusive to Alto de Inazares, in the region of Murcia.

Originally from Burgundy, its perfect adaptation to the clay, loam, and intense cold of Inazares allows this wine to reveal itself in a very personal manner.

CONTEXT

Growing area: Inazares
(Moratalla-Region of north-west Murcia)

Production area: Inazares. On the property.

Plot: La Tinaja (El Altico estate).

Soil: Clayey with a calcareous base, clay, alluvium.
Superficial.

Climate: Dry continental climate with influence of mountain climate.
Hurricane-force winds, precipitation in the form of snow.

Altitude: 1,373 m.

VINEYARD

Variety: Pinot Noir on trellis, Cordon Royat single.
Ecological cultivation.
Year planted: 2011.

HARVEST AND VINIFICATION

Harvest of September 23th, 2021.

0.9 kg/vine. 12 kg boxes.

Destemmed and lightly crushed.

Maceration for 8 days, seven of which in cold maceration.

Alcoholic fermentation with neutral yeast
at a controlled temperature of between 20°C and 24°C.

Daily pigeage.

36% of the wine is aged in a French oak barrel on its 7th use for six months.

The rest is aged on fine lees in a stainless-steel tank.

Light filtration (between 3 and 5 microns).
